

Title: Introducing Project Status Collaboration Interface

#	Question	Answer
1	Can either the data entry screens or reports be customized?	Yes. DRMcNatty can customize your solution to suite your needs as required. Enhancements or customizations to ProjectStatus are performed on a consulting basis.
2	How do the licenses work for ProjectStatus?	ProjectStatus is a subscription services and delivered to clients on a SaaS basis. Pricing is based on the number of users with best pricing options for larger user bases.
3	Can the scoring options be modified?	Yes. ProjectStatus utilizes the P6 Scoring Matrices and Thresholds to determine the project score. These items may be setup by the P6 system administrator and assigned to the appropriate projects.
4	When entering a new risk or issue within ProjectStatus, how long until I see the data in my P6 database?	ProjectStatus utilizes the P6 Web Services to automatically update the information Risk or Issue information directly in P6.
5	Is there a limit on the number of Risks that can be associated with a project through ProjectStatus?	No. There is no limit on the number of Risks or Issues which may be added.
6	If we have P6 Reports already created for Risks and Issues, can I still utilize the existing reports?	Yes. If you utilize BI Publisher for reporting of Risks and Issues within your P6 EPPM solution, you may still leverage all the functions of the built in EPPM BI Publisher reports.
7	Is the field for Risk Owner a UDF in P6?	No. The Owner field is mapped to the P6 resource dictionary.
8	Can I add new Risk Owners to my resource dictionary from within ProjectStatus or do I need to go into P6 to add new owners?	Users of ProjectStatus may add new resources directly to the P6 database for assignment as Risk Owners.
9	What if my security profile doesn't allow me to edit a risk?	You can view but not edit.
10	What do you still have to do in P6?	Thresholds, scoring matrix.
