What is it??

- Ease of Use application for non-schedulers to contribute information related to P6 projects.
- The following fields are available for Data Entry:
 1. Risks
 2. Issues
 3. Project Notebook Topics



P6 Collaboration Interface

Goal

- Expand the influence of P6 for organizations
- Create a optimal user experience
- Allow organizations to use all P6 features to their fullest
- Increase user adoption and “buy-in”



P6 Collaboration Interface

Client Benefits

- No java requirements
- Broad browser support (IE 9 and higher, Chrome, Firefox)
- Speed / Performance
- License Costs: Requires only a web service license



P6 Collaboration Interface

How it works

- Used with deployments of P6 EPPM 8.x and higher
- Users accounts created in P6 (min. Web Service License)
- P6 security controls project access
- Risk Thresholds / Scoring matrix required for scoring features (done in P6)
- UDF's used for Cost tracking fields



Risks vs. Issues

Risks

- Things that “may” effect the project
- Unforeseen Site Conditions



Issues

- Items which “are” effecting the project
- Required relocation of water line

Tracking cost between Projects, Risks, and Issues
