4	I issue a change directive that allows me to invoice the client for the work, but then am later issued a change order that collects multiple directives into one document. How is this handled?	Multiple Change Orders can be collected in a Pay Application for Payment using the Link CE button in the Pay Application for Payment.
5	I issue contracts to vendors that span multiple projects. How are changes handled if the change order spans multiple projects?	Change Orders are handled in a per project environment. Each Change Order would have to be done in that project.
