ORACLE PRIMAVERA P6 TURNING ON THE PROGRESS LINE

The Progress Line is a function of Primavera which allows users to graphically represent a variance between a set of user defined data points in the Gantt chart. Data Points can be chosen by right-clicking in the Gantt chart and selecting "Bar Chart Options".
