OVERVIEW

A county division selected Oracle Primavera Cloud to replace their existing, hosted Primavera P6 environment. DRMcNatty analyzed the existing set up and mirrored it in OPC. Historic and current projects were migrated from P6 to the new environment and custom reports were created to replace existing data extracts and reports.

Custom training was performed for both the application administrators and the individuals who would be managing and scheduling the projects.

APPROACH

The implementation was a 3 phased approach:

1. Analysis – Review of the existing user permissions and access; projects (current and historic); custom codes and fields; and reports to determine configuration and migration requirements
2. Configuration – Set up of OPC, including:
 - Permissions, user groups, and users
 - Workspaces
 - Programs
 - Custom Forms and Reports
 - Project and Activity level codes and configured fields
3. Migration – Transition of projects from the original environment to OPC
4. Training – Administrator and End User Training

RESULTS

The result was a smooth and rapid transition to the new OPC environment. Schedulers were able to begin scheduling and managing their projects upon completion of the training.
