#	Question	Answer
1	Could you please explain how to prioritize projects/schedules in P6? Or refer me to a source where I can find detailed information?	In P6 Pro you can use the "Leveling Priority Code" to filter and group project reports. In P6 EPPM (see screen to right), there is a column for "Project Score" and as seen in this example, you can also use User Defined Project fields to support scoring (prioritizing).
2	Can you please elaborate on integration with Unifier? Is it a one way direction or a two way?	P6 sends summarized duration, unit and cost data to Unifier that can be analyzed based on the Cost Breakdown Structure sent by Unifier into P6 for assignment to P6 activities. The integration, through Primavera Gateway, is one-way for the cost data. Integration between P6 and Prime for risk analysis is two-way.
3	Will you be doing a presentation on Primavera Prime sometime in the future?	Yes. Prime 14.2 was recently released and includes some new features including risk analysis.
4	Primavera Prime Capital Management, is this the product you were refering to, or do you mean Primavera Risk Analysis? Because on the Oracle Website the above are listed as two separate products?	Primavera Prime 14.2 includes risk analysis functionality. I was referring to Prime, not Primavera Risk. We will do a future webina comparing Primavera Risk to the risk functionality within Prime.
5	Still no ability to set manual page breaks in either P6 Bar Charts or Visualizer? Is this on Developments Radar?	Page breaking is by code. The only way to achieve a "manual" page break beyond that is experimenting with row height and spacing. Best source of what's on devel; opment radar is the Primavera SIG website at http://www.primaverasig.com/.
6	Is there an upcoming in-person Primavera Users Group Meeting?	Yes. Oracle Applications Users Group (OAUG) will be holding Oracle Collaborate 2015 on April 12-16, 2015 at Mandaly Bay Resort in Las Vegas. The Oracle Primavera Special Interest Group (OPSIG) is a part of Collaborate. This is an "in-person" event that is attended by hundreds of Primavera users. 7	Visualizer was having issues showing in your print preview. Have you encountered issues printing to pdf? Things like headers, footers appearing on all pages, or pages extending to a second page on the right. (These are examples of what we have encountered in 8.3)	I have had issues as well. More in Visualizer 8.4 than I had in 8.3. In 8.3 I noticed that if I switched the resolution on the page tab and then back to "one sheet" that the one-sheet drew a tighter drawing. I also found Nuance PDF to print better than PDF Annotator but with 8.4 they both are having problems.

9	You had mentioned and wanted clarifiction, Team Member is now available for purchase as a separate license for around \$800?	The last information we had was that it would be priced around \$940.00. That was not final and we are waiting for the revised price list.
10	Can P6 Web be installed on only a single computer or is it only on a server?	It's inteded for a multi-server environment. While it could be installed on a single machine, it's not supported and would require a very hefty machine and in-depth knowledge to install it.
11	Have you tested 8.4 with Ron Winters Sae Pro yet?	Yes. I was able to connect to an 8.4 db and run Baseline Checker with no problems. 8.4 has some different fields for summarization than 8.3. If any of Ron's reports try to access the summarized data fields there could be an issue, but none so far.
