#	Question	Answer
1	Accessing EPPM remotely and from outside our Firewall is really slow. What is the best solution available?	This is related to how your IT environment is configured. The only solution is to work with your IT Dept. to resolve the issues or to have the system hosted by an external hosting provider that are Subject Matter Experts (SME's) on P6 EPPM. Please contact us if you would like to see if hosting is right for you.
2	Does P6 EPPM come with a simpler version for non-routine users, that can be used for just simple tasks of viewing? An Example of this kind of product would be MS ACCESS Runtime Version	P6 Team Member is intended for use by non-routine users. Web Services licenses in P6 also support self-deployment of simple role based interfaces.
3	What are some of the "Workflow" applications in P6 EPPM?	P6 includes a license for Oracle's Business Process Manager (BPM) which is a non-Primavera product. Our preference to add workflows to P6 would be to either use Unifier or a third party tool such as Pentaho.
4	Can a single standard view be developed and saved to be emailed to be used by staff with a different set of projects to update?	There's no way to do this from a single view, you would create a single view in the Activities Screen and then email to each staff member who would be limited by P6 security as to which projects/activities they could see.
5	Schedule Check report looks very similar to the DCMA 14 Point Assessment. Are there differences?	Schedule Check report is modeled on the DCMA Assessment. You can see additional explanation of the DCMA requirements in the attached technical document from Ron Winter.
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
